### **Indoor Locations**

- In the highrise lobbies
- In the lobbies and lounges of Cedar, Sycamore, Hickory and Wallis.
- In the trash rooms of Hawthorn, Oak, Witherspoon, Miltimore, Lynch & Wallis.

### **Outdoor Locations**

- Lynch: at the bottom of lot 20 (Witherspoon/Lynch parking lot)
- Moore: near the dumpster behind the building\*
- Sanford: near the dumpster behind the building\*
- Greek Village: near the dumpster area
- Holshouser, Scott, and Hunt Village: behind Holshouser\*
- Martin Village: in the parking lot, near the J building\*
- Miltimore: behind the building near the mechanical room and dumpster
- Hawthorn: near the dumpster\*
- Phase IVA: across from the CAB building
- Phase V: parking lot near the dumpster at Elm
- Wallis & Witherspoon: Between Wallis and Witherspoon \*
