ALL-INCLUSIVE RATES

Our per semester rates are all-inclusive and consist of rent, laundry, all utilities, cable TV, high-speed wired and wireless Internet. As an on campus resident, your per semester rate also includes membership in the Resident Student Association (RSA), a student-run organization that helps us deliver social and academic-related programs to all of our residents.

MEAL PLANS

All freshmen residents, regardless of where they live, are required to purchase a meal plan. All residents of traditional and suite housing are required to purchase a meal plan. Upper class residents living in apartments and our Greek Village area may choose a meal plan, but are not required to purchase one. Meal plan fees are not included in the Housing rates.
